We also believe that we will **learn to appreciate the small things**: a hot shower, a mattress, a full plate of food... We are used to living with all kinds of comforts and privileges, luxuries that we won't have there. We think that this will be a very enriching experience for us.

Another aspect that we have talked about a lot is the following: *How are we actually going to help in something like this?* In a situation that feels so distant from our own, we are full of doubts about how much use we can really be in such a context. However, we are sure that we will do our best so that our cooperation truly supports this project, which we both feel deeply interested in.

We hope that the knowledge we've acquired during our studies will be helpful in this project, and that our nerves — as two girls who have hardly left their hometowns — won't get in the way. Even so, we are very aware that **an opportunity like this only comes once in a lifetime**, and for that reason we will work hard on our insecurities in order to give 100%.
